

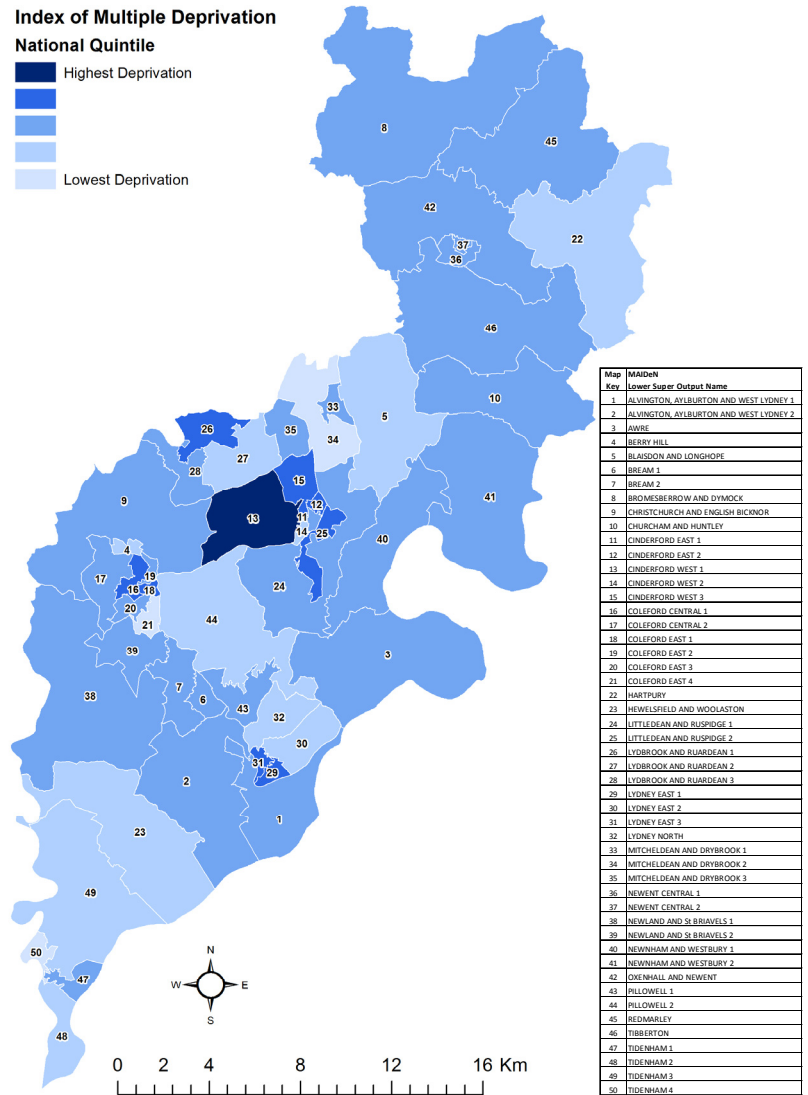
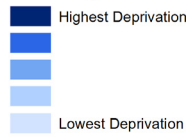
# The English Indices of Deprivation 2015 Forest of Dean District Summary

Forest of Dean is the **2<sup>nd</sup> most deprived district** in Gloucestershire and ranks as the **155<sup>th</sup>** most deprived of the 326 districts in England

Forest of Dean is home to the **least deprived LSOAs** in the county for:  
**“Health Deprivation and Disability”** (Tidenham 4),  
**“Crime and Disorder”** (Hewelsfield and Woolaston), and  
**“Living Environment”** (Lydney East 2)

**54% of the population** of Forest of Dean live in areas of **average deprivation** (middle national quintile of the Index of Multiple Deprivation).
