

## Inform Gloucestershire

### Adult Social Care Survey 2018/19 Findings

Councils with Adult Social Services responsibilities in England are required to carry out an annual postal survey of those who have received Adult Social Care and Support Services.

#### Eligible population, sample size and response rates

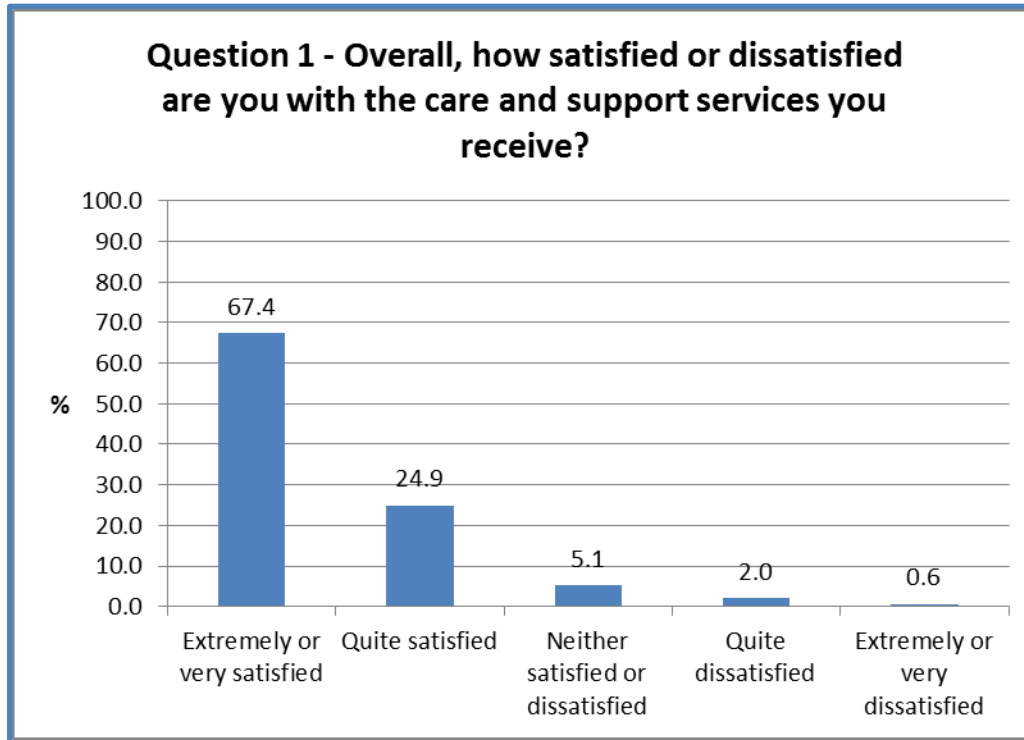
- ❖ In Gloucestershire, just over **4,892** residents were eligible for the 2018/19 survey.
- ❖ A random sample of **1,458** people were selected for the survey. The questionnaires were sent out in January 2019 and again in February as a reminder.
- ❖ A total of **678** questionnaires were completed and returned, giving a response rate of **46.5%**.

#### Key findings

- ❖ Overall, **67.4%** of respondents were extremely or very satisfied with the care and support services they received, with a further 24.9% who were quite satisfied.
- ❖ **95.4%** of respondents said the care and support services they received had helped them to achieve a better quality of life.
- ❖ **64.8%** reported that they had enough choice over care and support services, and **79.7%** felt they had as much control as they want or adequate control over their daily life.
- ❖ **91.5%** of respondents felt care and support services had helped them in having control over their daily life.
- ❖ **92%** of respondents felt the services had helped them in feeling safe.
- ❖ For those who had tried to find information and advice about support, services or benefits, **71.3%** found it very or fairly easy to find such information or advice.

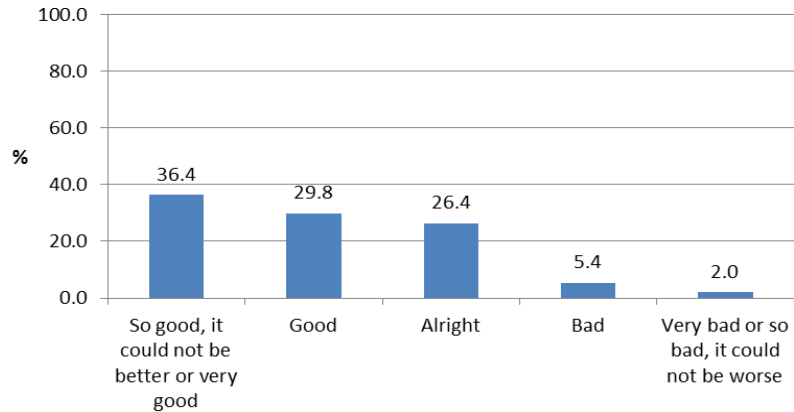

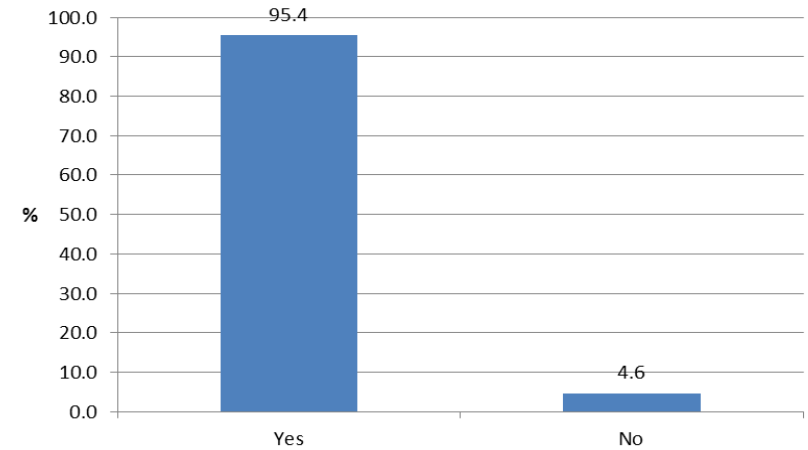

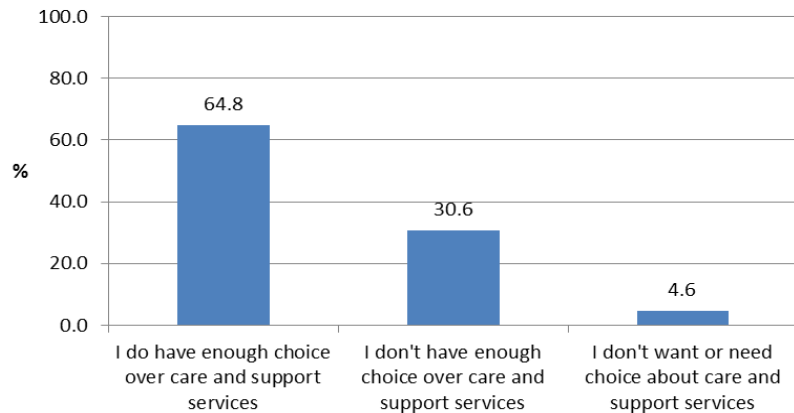
**Question 2 - Thinking about the good and bad things that make up your quality of life, how would you rate the quality of your life as a whole?**



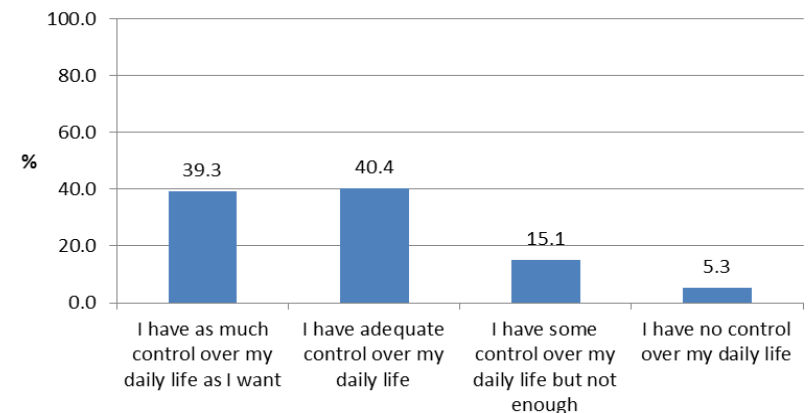
**Question 2b - Do care and support services help you to have a better quality of life?**



**Question 2c - Which of the following statements best describes how much choice you have over care and support services you receive?**

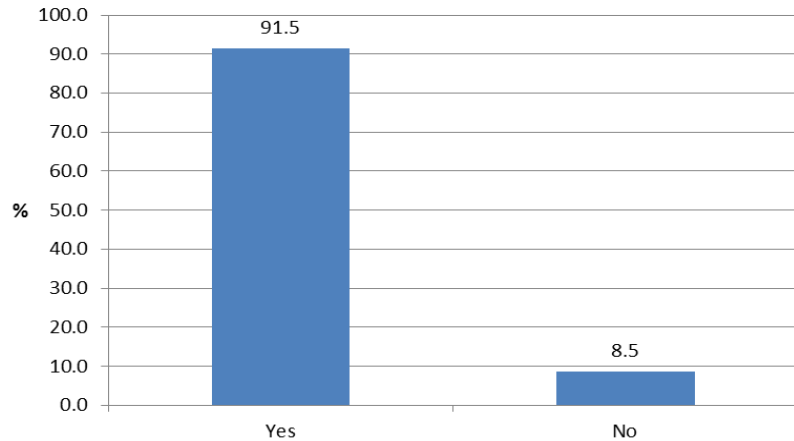


**Question 3a - Which of the following statements best describes how much control you have over your daily life?**

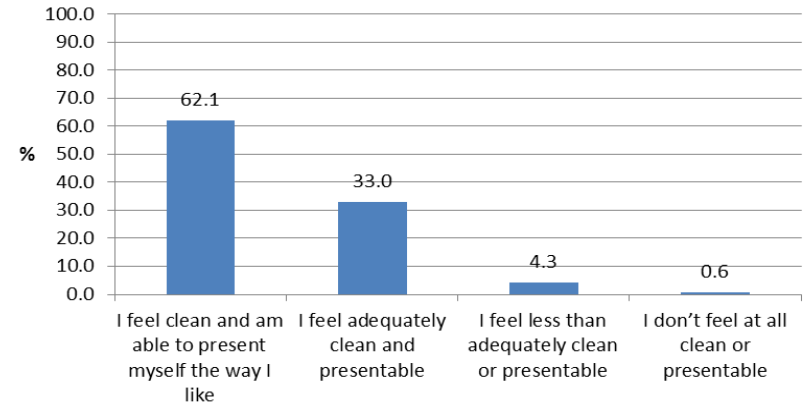

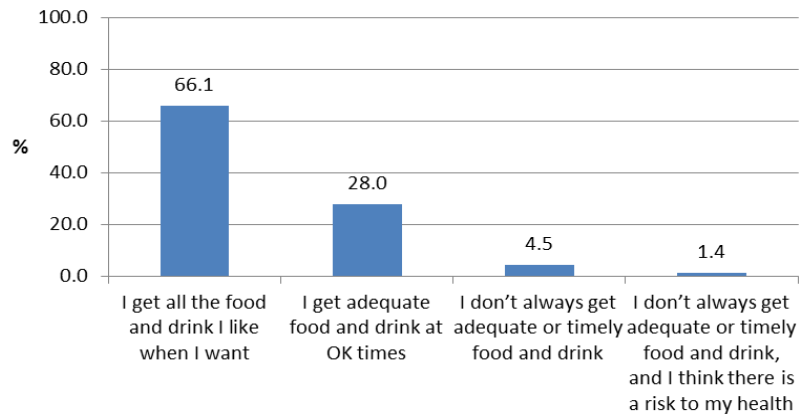
**Question 3b - Do care and support services help you in having control over your daily life?**



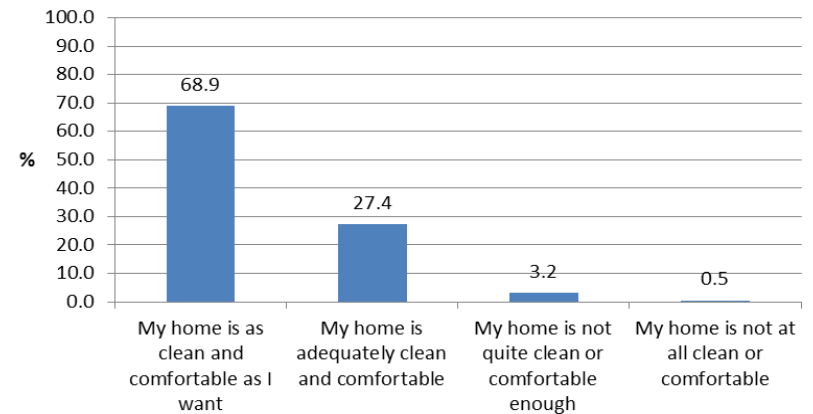
**Question 4a - Thinking about keeping clean and presentable in appearance, which of the following statements best describes your situation?**

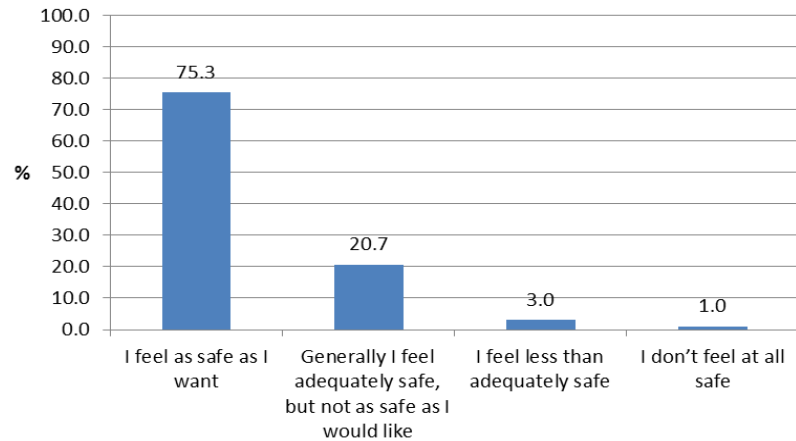

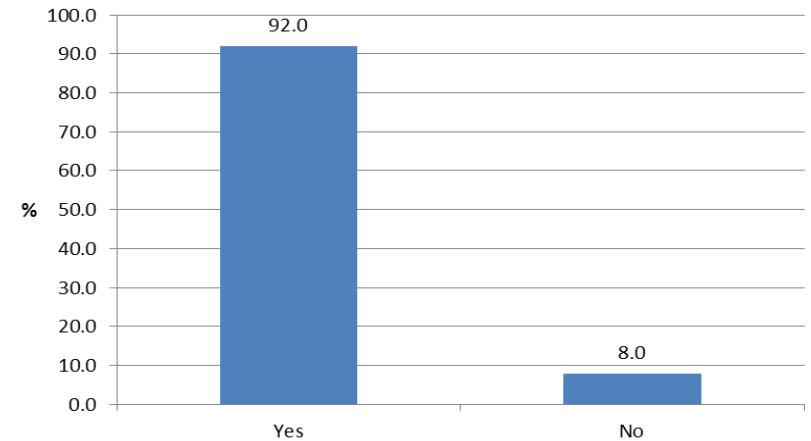

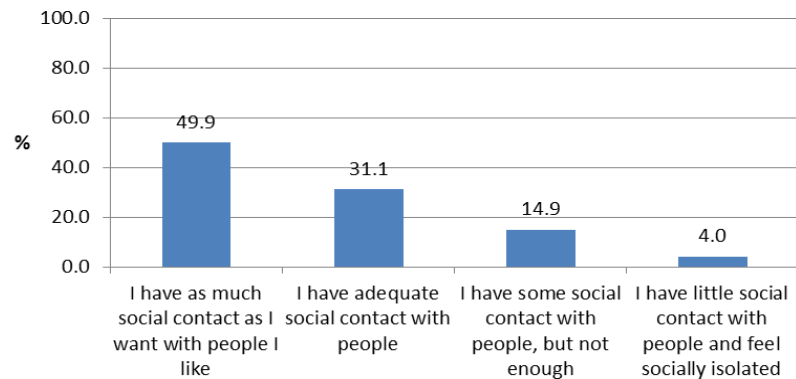

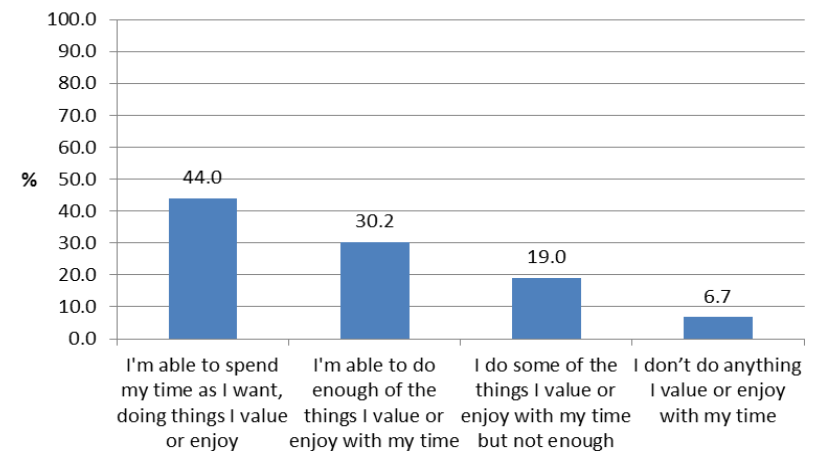
**Question 7b - Do care and support services help you in feeling safe?**



**Question 8a - Thinking about how much contact you've had with people you like, which of the following statements best describes your social situation?**

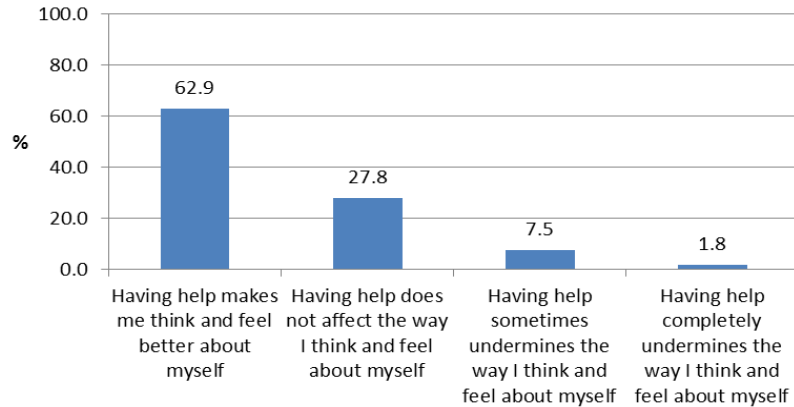

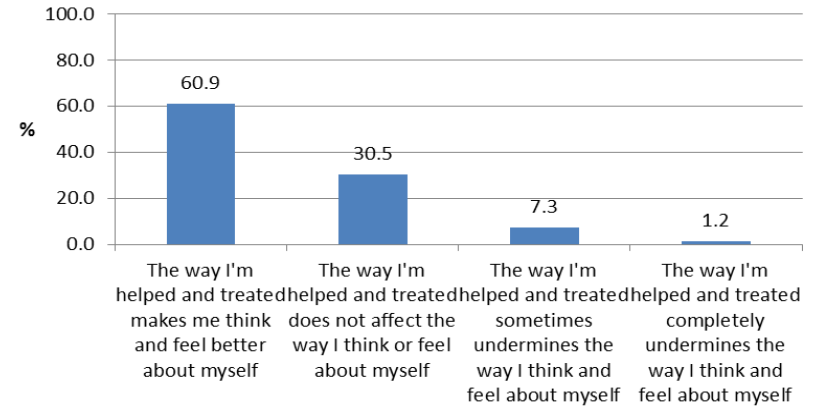

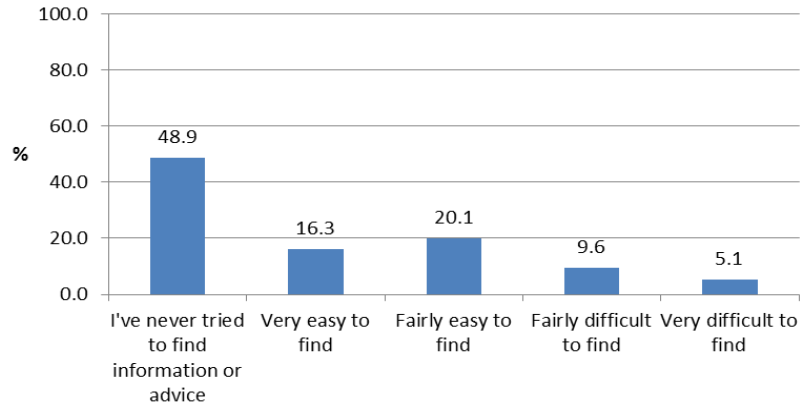

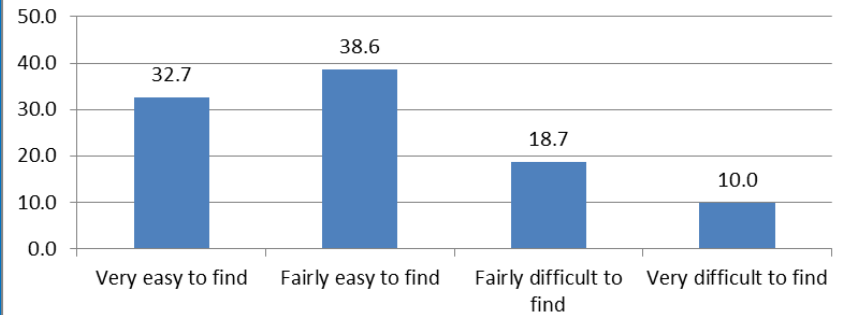

**Question 12 - In the past year, have you generally found it easy or difficult to find information and advice about support, services or benefits?**

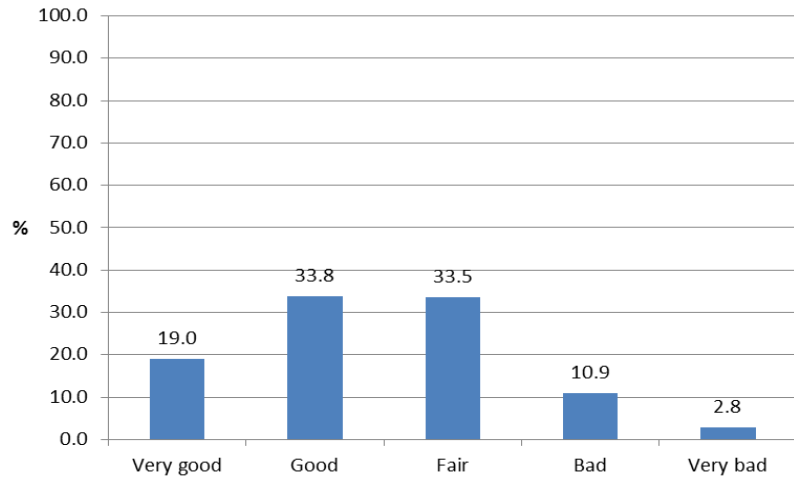


**Question 12a - In the past year, have you generally found it easy or difficult to find information and advice about support, services or benefits? (Excluding those who had never tried to find information or advice)**

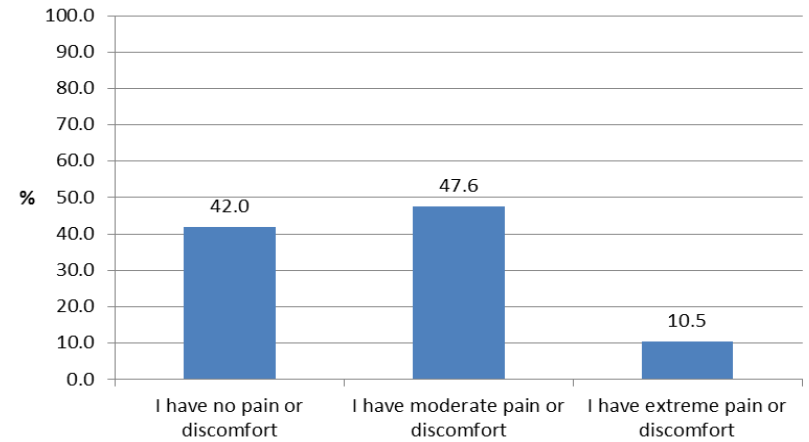

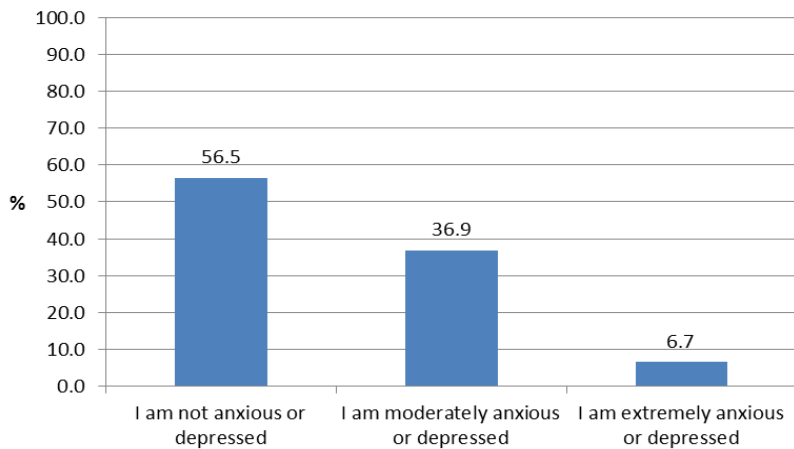

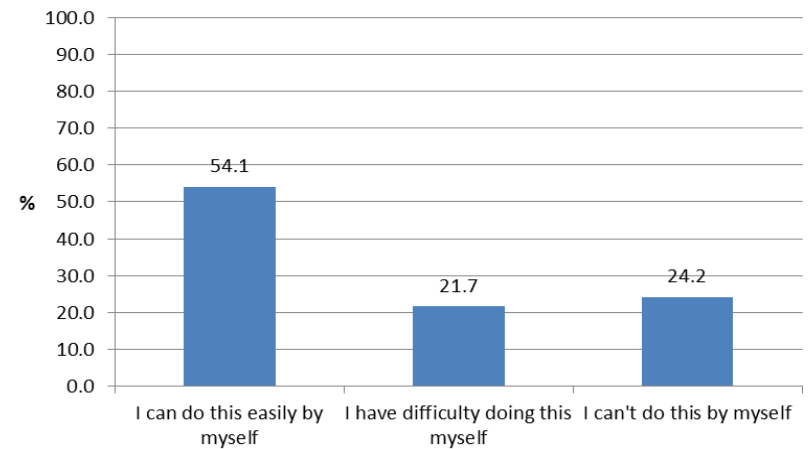
**Q14a - Which statements best describe your own health state today - Pain or discomfort**



**Q14b - Which statements best describe your own health state today - Anxiety or depression**



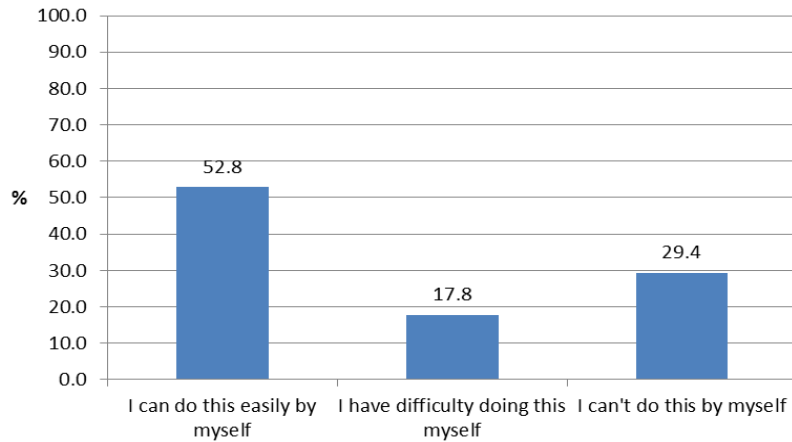
**Question 15a - Do you usually manage to get around indoors (except steps) by yourself?**



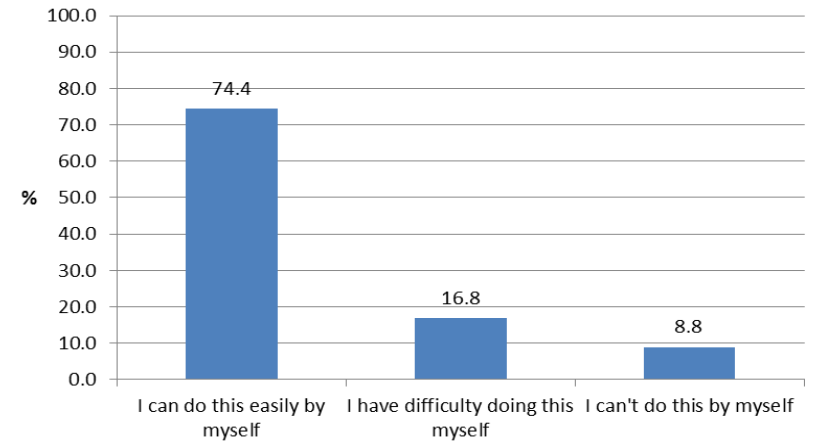

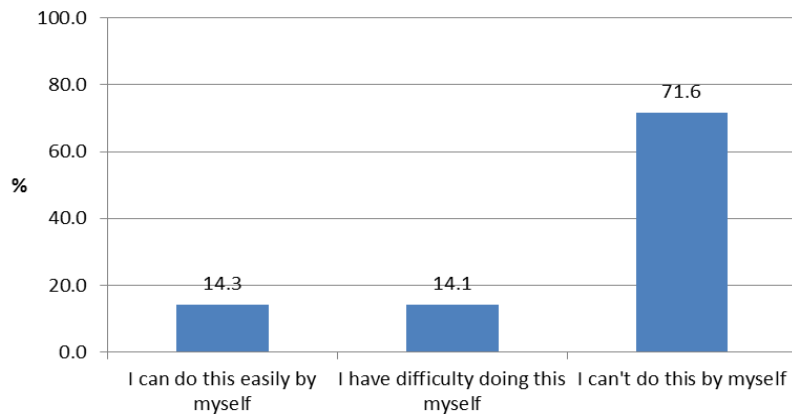
**Question 15b - Do you usually manage to get in and out of a bed (or chair) by yourself?**



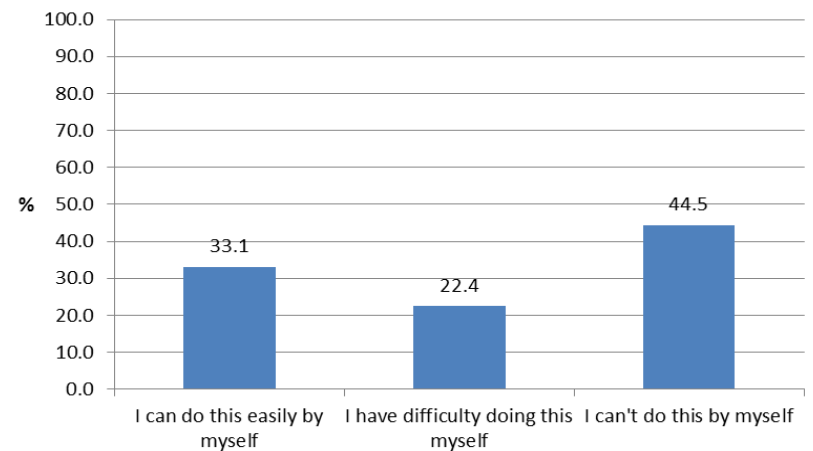

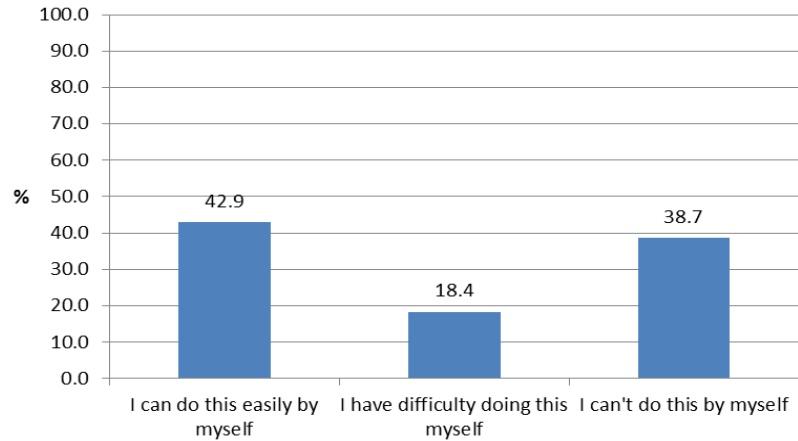


**Question 16a - Do you usually manage to wash all over by yourself, using either a bath or shower?**

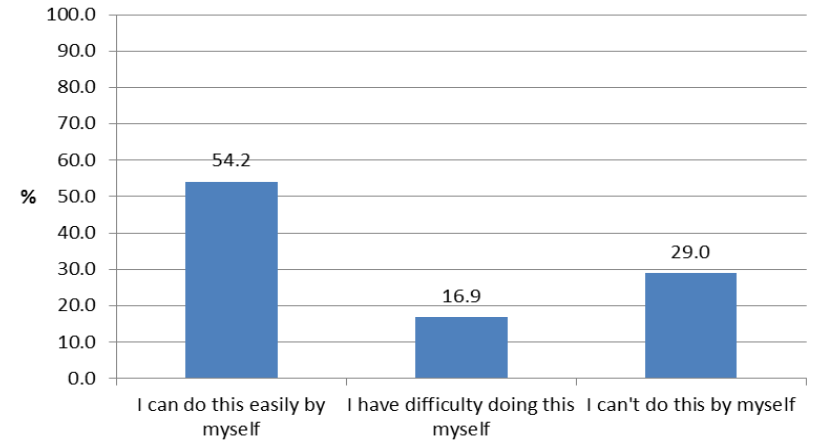

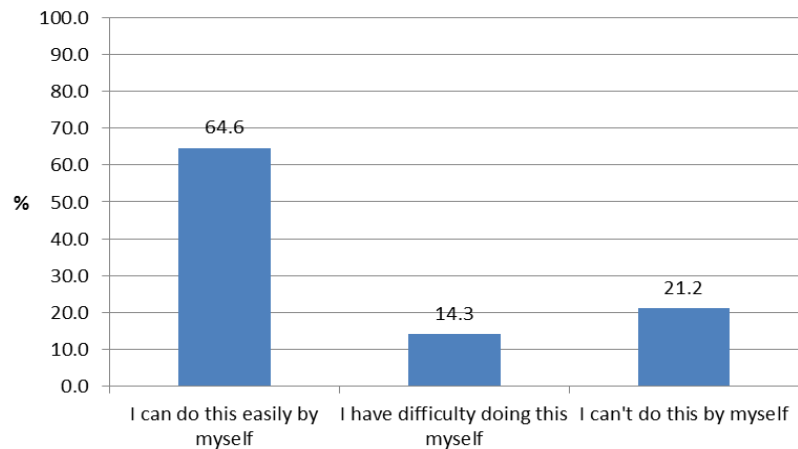

**Question 16c - Do you usually manage to use the WC/toilet by yourself?**

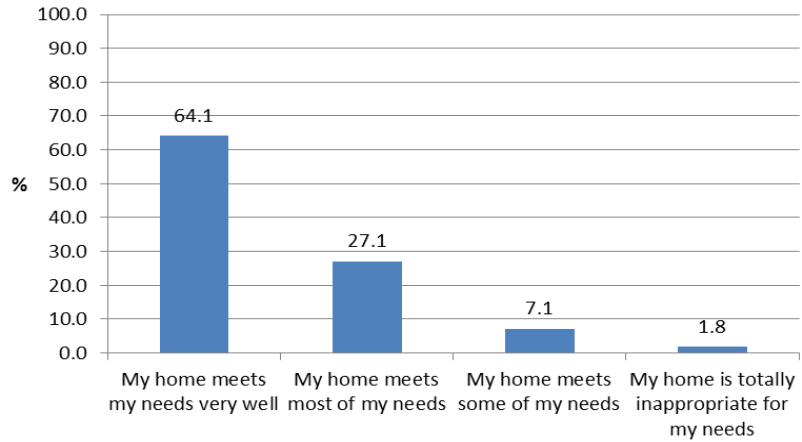

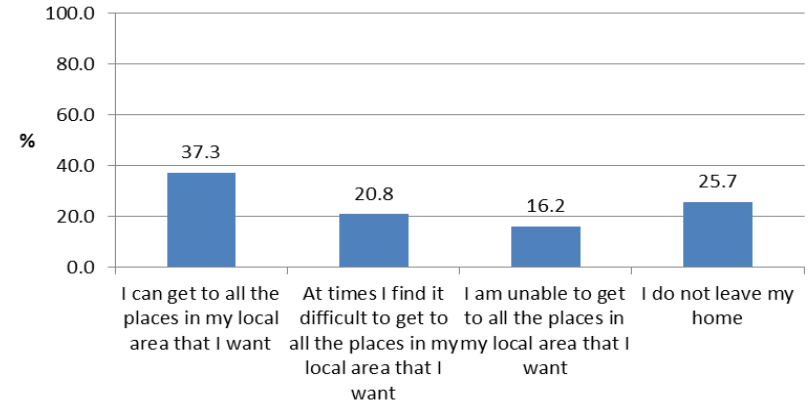

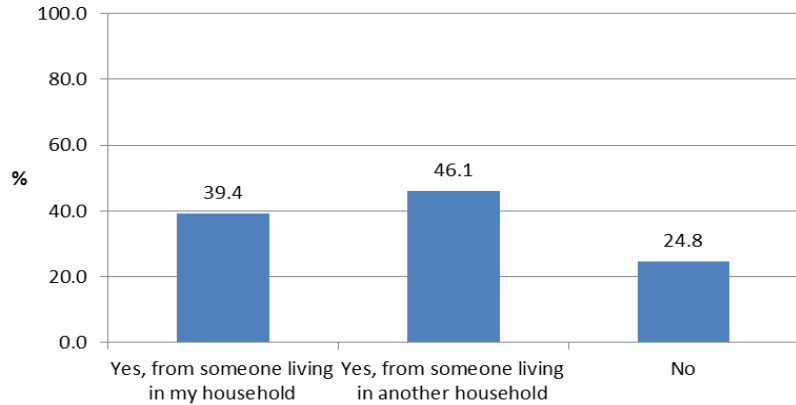


**Question 18 - Thinking about getting around outside of your home, which of the following statements best describes your present situation?**

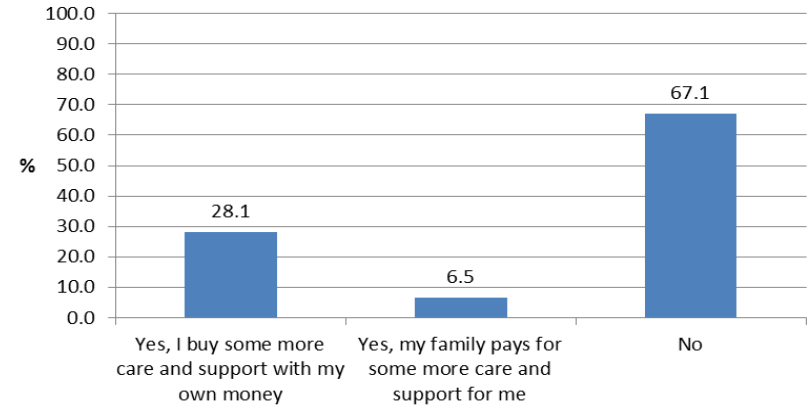

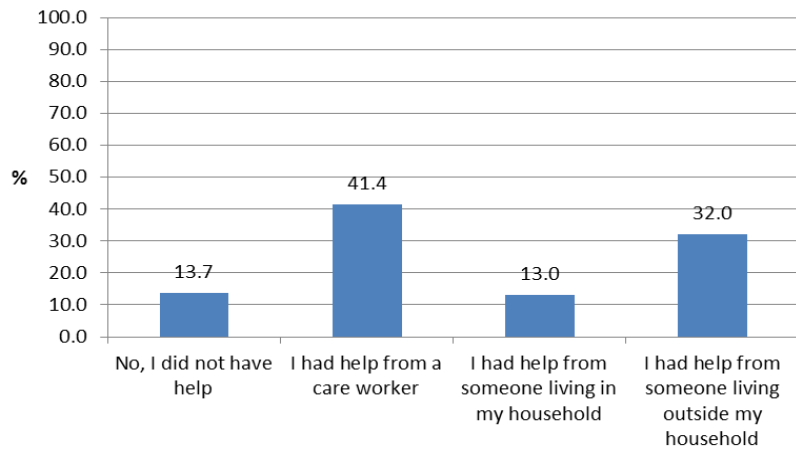
