**'Gloucestershire continues to have a growing and ageing population...'**



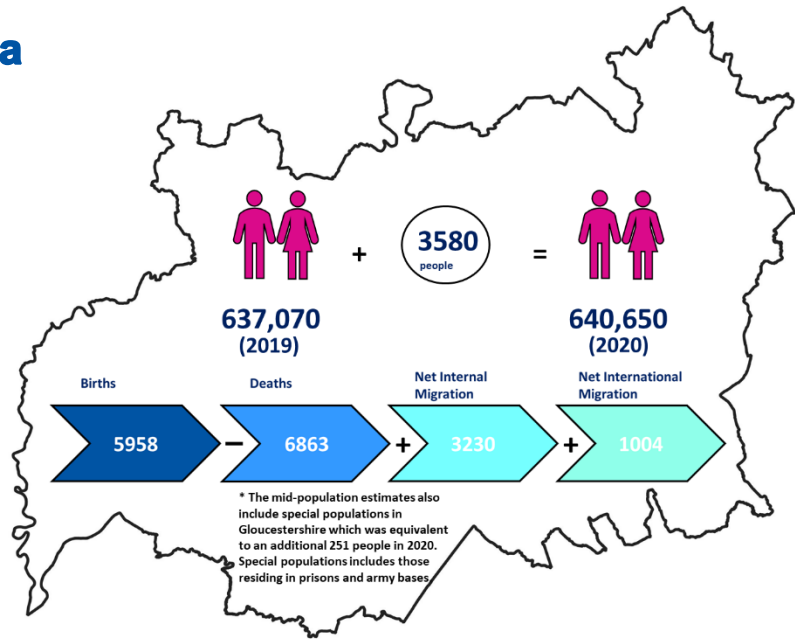
Gloucestershire's population has increased by **3,580** people since 2019.

There were more deaths than births between 2019-2020.

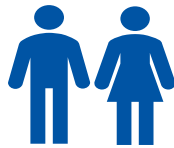
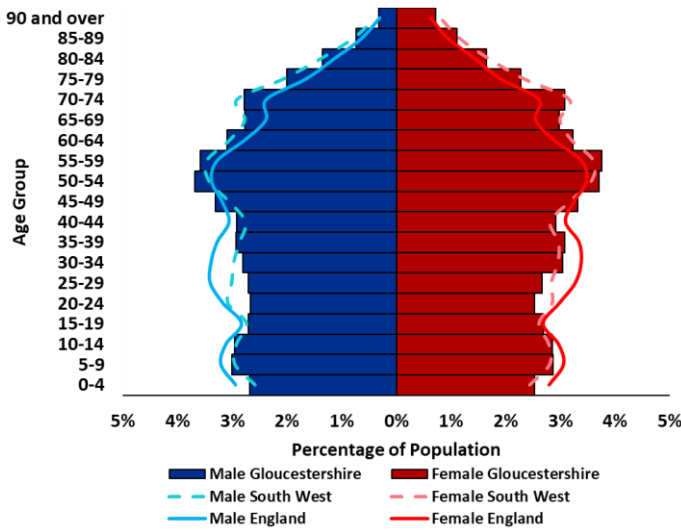

For every **100** males, there are **104** females in Gloucestershire.

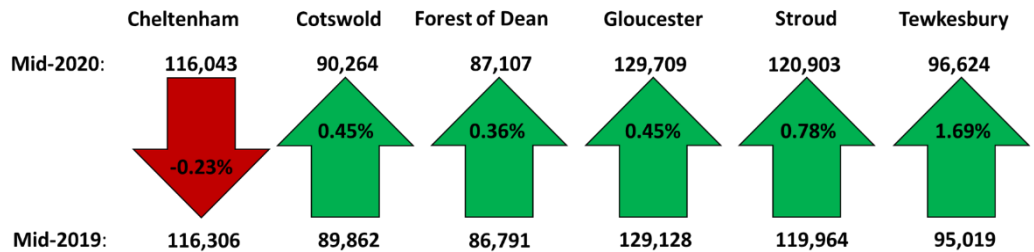


Gloucestershire's working age population accounts for **55.9%** of the total population which is lower than England, **57.9%**, but marginally higher than the South West, **55.7%**.

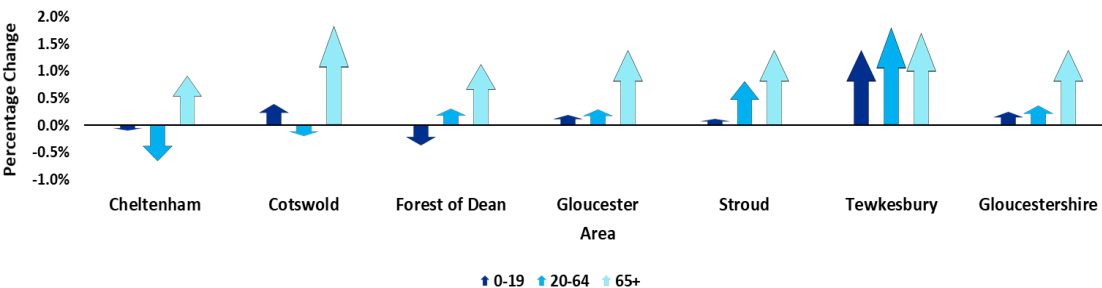


The **median age** of someone living in Gloucestershire is **44.5** which is higher than in 2010 when it was **42.3**.
